

Sponsor Agreement (Sponsor is referred to as “organization” in agreement below.)

1. I hereby acknowledge that I have voluntarily agreed to be a resource at the Autism Empowerment Easter Egg Hunt for Acceptance of All Abilities. This Release and Waiver of Liability (the “release”) releases Autism Empowerment (the “nonprofit”), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of Washington, and each of its directors and its event partners, The Miracle League of Vancouver and Innovative Services Northwest (the “partners”) also organized and existing under the laws of the state of Washington, and each of their directors.

2. Waiver and Release: I release and forever discharge and hold harmless the Nonprofit and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims and demands of whatever kind of nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from said group or organization’s participation in the Easter Egg Hunt. I understand and acknowledge that this Release discharges the Nonprofit and its partners from any liability or claim that I may have against the Nonprofit or its Partners with respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death or property damage that may result from participation in the Autism Empowerment Easter Egg Hunt.

3. Insurance: Further, I understand that the Nonprofit and partners does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide said organization with fiscal or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health or disability benefits or insurance of any nature in the event of injury, illness, death or damage of my property. I expressly waive any such claim for compensation or liability on the part of the Nonprofit or partners in the event of such injury or medical expense incurred by my organization taking part in the event.

4. Medical Treatment: I hereby release and forever discharge the Nonprofit and partners from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered in connection with an emergency during the organization’s participation in the Easter Egg Hunt.

5. Assumption of Risk: I understanding that participation in the Easter Egg Hunt may include activities that may be hazardous, and I hereby expressly assume the risk of injury or harm from these activities and Release the Nonprofit and its partners from all liability for injury, illness, death or property damage resulting from the organization’s participation in the activities or occurring while the organization is participating in the activities including set-up time.

6. Photographic and Copyright Release: I grant and convey to Nonprofit and partners all right, title, and interest in any and all photographs, images, video or audio recording of the organization or likeness or voice made by the Nonprofit and its partners in connection with the Easter Egg Hunt. I further grant and convey to the Nonprofit and its partners all rights, title and interests in any and all work, including but not limited to photographs, images, video, audio recording taken and/or produced by the organization in connection with the Easter Egg Hunt. This release covers, Autism Empowerment, Miracle League of Vancouver, Innovative Services NW, TSS Photography or any other agent of the nonprofit.

7. Other: I expressly agree that this Release shall be intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Washington and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington. I agree that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release is deemed invalid, the enforceability of the remaining provisions of the Release shall not be affected.

8. It is understood that each organization, group or vendor will provide their own tables, chairs or pop-up tents as so desired and the nonprofit or its partners are not responsible for any loss or damage to the participating organization’s property.

9. It is understood that this an outdoor event and the event will be held rain or shine. No refunds will be given and any unsold Silent Auction items will be used by Autism Empowerment at a future date. A \$50.00 fee will be charged for any returned checks.

10. It is understood that the gates will be open up to the public at or about 1:00 pm and that booths / tables should be set up by **12:30 pm** the date of the event. You will be able to get get in as early as **11:00 am** the day of the event. Please check in with the Resource Coordinator the day of the event to confirm your location. Your organization must be **off the field by 4:00 pm**.

11. For a \$25 fee, Autism Empowerment will include marketing materials from your organization or group in a take home bag that families will receive at the event. You can provide us up to 4 pages of information, including business cards and brochures. We recommend you provide between 500 - 750 copies. Autism Empowerment reserves the right to not put materials in the take home bag if the materials are not suitable. If there are leftover bags at the end of the event, Autism Empowerment will give the bags out at other Autism Empowerment events until all the materials are given out.
